Mythological Creatures

Paul Kavik (1957-2007)

Baker Lake, Nunavut 1979

33.5" x 25"

The artist, recently deceased, is one of only four Inuit men known to have done wallhangings. Created when he was in his early 20s, it may be the only one he ever did. He is the grandson of the famous Rankin Inlet artist John Kavik, the son of Martha Apsaq Qarliksaq, and the nephew of Naomi Ityi (all deceased), the latter two both being well known wallhanging artists from whom he likely learned embroidery work and imagery design. The seven mythological creatures (perhaps man-fish heads) are flanked by bears, geese, dogs, an owl, a seal, a wolf and what look like flying squirrels but could perhaps be lemmings.

Embroidery stitches used: cross, slanted buttonhole, incomplete chain, feather, stem, chain and detached chain.
